The 2015 Sanctuary Classic helps demonstrate:

- NOAA Sanctuaries are open to and support sustainable recreational fishing
- The "Classic" illustrates the benefits of light touch recreational fishing

Weekly Prize- Pair of Costa Sunglasses (\$250 value) to the person that submits the picture that best exemplifies fishing within Sanctuary waters and family/kids fishing together, responsible fishing, conservation-minded fishing techniques.

Weekly prize winner is determined by Sanctuary Classic staff

Pictures are submitted online and viewable for one week. Picture can be shared via social media, commented on, etc.

At the end of the contest (after Sept. 7) thirteen photos will be selected (one from each National Marine Sanctuary) that best represent Guy Harvey Ocean Foundation categories:

- Biggest (looking) Fish
- Smallest (looking) Fish
- Best Conservation Message
- Guy Harvey Spirit
- Most Family Oriented Photo
- Most Unique Looking Fish
- Largest Fish Compared to Angler
- Best Display of Responsible Fishing Values

Each photo that is selected will be awarded a \$1000 scholarship from the Guy Harvey Ocean Foundation.
